

OUTDOOR SPORTS NZ LTD
TERMS & CONDITIONS SELL A SAUER, SHOOT A SIKA
12 February 2018 – 31 May 2018

1. These terms and conditions (hereinafter the "Terms and Conditions") apply to the competition referred to in clauses 7 to 10 (**Competition**) organized by Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd and/or its subsidiaries or its affiliated companies (**Provider**). By entering the Competition, the participant (**Participant**) agrees to the following Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Participants aged 18 or over.
3. Entry is only open to New Zealand residents. Excluded from participation are staff and relatives of Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd (including its subsidiaries) and cohabiting partners or family of the aforementioned employees as well as any suppliers in respect of the particular competition (including advertising agencies, advertisers, sponsors or producers).
4. By entering the Competition each Participant will be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.
5. The Participant is obliged to provide accurate, current and complete information when participating in the Competition and failure to supply might result in the entry being invalid. The Provider may require that a Participant who wins the Competition (**Winner**) provide proof of their identity (which may include government issued identification) and residence information before presenting the Prize.
6. No responsibility will be taken for late/lost/misdirected mail, incomplete entries or entries with incorrect postage. Entries will be deemed to be void if stolen, forged, mutilated or tampered with in any way.
7. **How to enter:** During the promotion period, the Participant must sell a Sauer Rifle that has been supplied by Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd, through their retail store. Each Sauer Rifle sold during this period entitles the Participant to an entry into the Competition. Only one entry by online, post or email will be accepted for each Sauer Rifle sold.
8. The Participant must enter online at www.outdoorsportsnz.com or by filling out a paper entry form and returning it to Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd, PO Box 100 158, North Shore Mail Centre, Auckland, with proof of sale of a Sauer Rifle.
9. **Promotion Period:** The promotion commences at 8.00am on Monday 12th February 2018 and concludes at 11:59pm on Thursday 31st May 2018.
10. **The Prize:** Two overnight 'Meat Hunt' Adventures to be won (**Prize**). The Prize includes the cost of travel to and from the Meat Hunt location, accommodation during the Meat Hunt, meals during the Meat Hunt & Ridgeline and/or Sauer Hunting apparel consisting of a Jacket, pants and cap each. The Meat Hunt will take place at a location to be confirmed in the North Island. To the fullest extent permitted by law the Provider will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered by the Winner in connection with the competition.

12. The Provider is not responsible for any acts of God, such as adverse weather conditions or industrial action or civil commotion that may occur during or in connection with the use of the Prize. It is the responsibility of the Winner to enquire about local issues and conditions at destinations prior to travel. The Provider does not guarantee that the Winner will enjoy the Prize or be suited to the type of Prize that is offered.

14. Only entries received by the closing date specified in these Terms and Conditions will be accepted.

Winners will be notified by the email address and/or phone number supplied in the entry form. If the Winner cannot be contacted within 3 days, that Winner will forfeit the prize with no right of compensation and the prize will be redrawn by Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd.
16. The decision of Outdoor Sports NZ Ltd in relation to any aspect of the competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
17. Participants agree to their names being published and to be photographed for publicity purposes.
18. Unless they opt out Participants consent to receive promotional and other marketing messages from the Provider (including messages sent electronically for an unlimited period of time). Participants will be able to opt-out at any time by notifying the Provider or in the case of electronic messages following the instructions included in each message.

20. If any of these terms and conditions is or becomes invalid, void, illegal or unenforceable, to the extent permitted by law, the remaining provisions will not be affected, prejudiced or impaired.
21. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and in accordance with New Zealand law and Participants submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the New Zealand courts.
